After you have completed your spellings, spelling sheets, phonics, tables, mental maths, have some fun away from screens today! Here are some ideas for this week!



1. Build a balloon Lego car! Once you have built your car, inflate the balloon and see how far it can travel!

2. Enjoy a garden scavenger hunt. Pick as many items as you wish to find.



3. Make a pom-pom catcher! Ask an adult to carefully cut the bottom of a plastic or paper cup. Cut the top of a balloon and stretch the balloon over the bottom of the cup. Now you can pull the balloon and ping a scrunched up ball of paper, cotton wool, pom-pom. How many can you catch? What makes the item move? What force is being used?

4. If it is dry, lie out in the garden for 10 minutes and watch the cloud formations. Can you see any objects, animals, creatures made from the clouds? If you have some cotton wool or a white crayon you could make what you saw on some blue paper!
5. Make a circuit of training activities for your family to do. Star jumps, sit ups, throwing and catching, hoola-hooping and whatever you think would be great fun! Remember to be safe and careful though!
