After you have completed your spellings, spelling sheets, phonics, tables, mental maths, have some fun away from screens today! Here are some ideas for this week!

1. Create some silhouette art! Draw the outline of the animal or person or object you wish to create a silhouette of. Gather some old magazines and carefully cut into thin strips. Always be careful with scissors. Glue the strips onto the outline.
2. Enjoy a colour scavenger hunt. Pick 9 colours and colour them onto paper. Go on a scavenger hunt in the garden to see if you can find something that colour.



3. Gather some twigs, sticks and make a giant tic-tac-toe grid. You could use stones, pine cones, leaves, etc. as the x's and o's.
4. Make a target game. Mark out lines or hoops or circles and give them a score. You can use a ball, bean bag or rolled up socks to throw at the target. Can you calculate your score?



5. Experiment with paper and junk art materials to see if you can make a kite? What is the best shape? What is the best material? How long does it stay in the sky?
